The services include educational, emotional, treatment, and financial

support, as well as wellness for survivors. They rely on donations, grants and fundraisers to support their many efforts. As in the past, local youth from some of the Montauk School and EHHS will showcase their musical talents on Friday afternoon. In addition, a graduating senior from EHHS will once again be the recipient of a MMF Scholarship.
